Institute has established **MK Tata Memorial Centre for the Visually Challenged** in order facilitate access to learning resources in print as well as online formats to visually challenged users.

This Centre is equipped with following assistive technologies:

- Multimedia computers with scanners for reading print materials,
- JAWS for converting normal PC into a talking PC,
- Kurzweil K1000 OCR Reading software,
- Basic D Braille Embosser for production of Books in Braille.
- Highly qualified and trained staff in assistive technologies



JAWS Pro Talking Software: For conversion of a normal PC into a Talking PC to enable the blind to operate computers independently including Internet Access and also to train blind persons on using the computer.



Basic D Braille Printer

- Basic D Braille Embosser for production of Books in Braille.
- Useful support for visually challenged students who would like to read literature in Braille
